Ed Bram was a former EAIFO, ECAC football official from Philadelphia. His son, Gerry (Smasher) Bram followed his footsteps into College officiating.

BRAM, Edward H., 77, of Trinity, died March 1, 2006, at Community Hospital of New Port Richey. He was born in Philadelphia, Pa., and moved to Florida six years ago from Philadelphia.
