



## 2008 NCAA Football Test

This test is designed to help prepare officials who officiate football using NCAA rules and interpretations. The most successful results will come from dialogue and discussion with other officials. We trust you will find this resource helpful in preparing you for the upcoming 2008 season. These are the questions that you will answer in the online test.

### NEW RULES

1. A low-low block anywhere on the field, with or without delay between contacts is an illegal chop block.

## REPLAY

17. 1st & 10 on B's 20. The slot receiver moves up to the line of scrimmage, which leaves him between the left tackle and flexed end. Slot receiver goes downfield, catches a pass on B's 8 and advances for a touchdown. Officials rule touchdown. Replays show that the slot receiver was on the line and "covered".

18. 3rd & goal on B's 10. Tailback runs to B's 5 and fumbles. The covering official rules that the "loose" ball hit a goal line pylon and immediately signals a touchback. Several players muff the ball before the tailback recovers in Team B's end zone. Replays show the ball did not hit the pylon.

19. 4th & 10 on B's 20. The game clock shows 11:20 in the 2nd quarter. Team A's field goal attempt is blocked. Team A's left tackle recovers on B's 21 and runs for a touchdown. After the touchdown, officials rule that the left tackle recovered the ball on B's 19 and make it B's ball, 1st and 10 on B's 19.

20. 1st & 10 on A's 39. The game clock shows 1:45 in the fourth quarter. The score is A21-B19. Team A has no timeouts remaining. Team A receiver is downed on A's 49. The HL spots the ball on A's 48. Replays show that the ball was on A's 49 when Team A receiver was downed.

- A. Reviewable, A 1/10 @ A49
- B. Not reviewable, A 2/1 @ A48

## END OF QUARTER

21. Last timed down of the 4th quarter Team A scores a TD making the score Team A 20, Team B 21. An opponent of the scoring team commits a personal foul during the down.

- A. The penalty must be enforced on the try. There is no succeeding kickoff.
- B. Team A has the option to carry the personal foul over to the extra period assuming their PAT kick is successful.

22. Team A kicks a successful field goal to tie the game on the last timed down of regulation. The Team B defensive end commits a personal foul during the down behind or beyond the line of scrimmage.

- A. If penalty is accepted, extend period. Team A's ball. If penalty is declined, score counts. No post-scrimmage kick exception when field goal successful.

23. On a point after TD, the Team B defensive tackle commits a personal foul during a successful try. Team A elects to take the one point try.

- A. The penalty is enforced to start the first extra period. The ball is put in play on the 12 1/2 or the 40 depending on what team is on offense first.

34. 3rd and 12 @ B's 43. The score is A22-B24. Twelve seconds remain in the fourth quarter. Team A running back advances to B's 4 where he pitches the ball forward when he is about to be tackled. Team A right tackle catches the ball in B's end zone. Three seconds remain on the clock.

- A. A 1st and goal @ B's 9; clock on the ready for play.
- B. A 1st and goal @ B's 9; clock on the snap.
- C. A 3rd and 17 @ B's 48; clock on the ready.
- D. A 3rd and 17 @ B's 48; clock on the snap.

35. 3rd and 18 @ A's 42. Team A QB is sacked on A's 28. Time expires in the first half during the down. Team A commits an illegal shift foul. Team A tight end commits an unsportsmanlike foul after the down ends. Team A is expected to kickoff to start the second half.

- A. Team B is not permitted to carry over the unsportsmanlike conduct foul to the 2nd half.
- B. Team B may decline the Team A illegal shift and carry over the unsportsmanlike foul to the second half kickoff.

36. 3rd and goal @ B's 16. The score is A17-B22. Team A runner advances to B's 4 and when he is about to be tackled, flips the ball forward to the Team A tight end who catches the ball in B's end zone. Time expires in the fourth quarter during the down.

37. Extra period. First team possession. Team A's ball 2nd and 9 @ B's 24. Team B defender intercepts Team A's legal forward pass. During interception return and prior to scoring, the Team B defender taunts his opponent on A's 7 by pointing the ball toward him.

- A. B 1/10 @ B4. The clock starts on the snap.

40. 4th & 10 on A's 20. The score is tied. Team A's punt is illegally touched by a Team A player on B's 42, then picked up on B's 39 by a Team B player who runs five yards and fumbles. Team A recovers and picks up the fumble dragging a defender to Team B's goal line between the hash marks. The covering official signals a touchdown. During Team A's run, a Team B player has an incidental facemask in making the tackle. 4-seconds remain in the 4th quarter. Replay shows the Team A runner was downed on B's 1/2. Team B is coming out of the huddle to snap the ball on B's 42. Clock? Reviewable?

- A. A 1/goal B-1/4. The clock starts on the snap. The play is reviewable.
- B. A 1/goal B-1/2. The clock starts on the snap. The play is reviewable.

41. 4th & 9 on A's 40. Team B nose guard is offside. Team A punts. Team B receiver signals for a fair catch, catches the ball on B's 25 and advances. Team A player tackles the Team B runner on B's 35 by jerking his facemask. Clock?

  - C. A 4/9 @ A40. Penalties all offset. The clock starts on the ready for play.
42. 4th & 5 on A's 30. Team A punts. Team B player is in position to catch the punt on B's 34. A Team A flyer contacts this receiver on B's 34 just prior to the Team B player muffing the punt. The ball is rolling on B's 32 when an inadvertent whistle sounds.
- A. A 4/20 @ A15. The clock starts on the snap.
  - B. B 1/10 @ B47. The clock starts on the snap.

43. 4th & 7 on A's 34. Team A's punt is muffed by a Team A player who voluntarily stepped on the sideline while running downfield and recovers the ball on B's 36.

61. 4th and 4 @ B's 13. Team A running back takes a handoff and slants to B's 10 where he is downed. Team B defensive end was offside at the snap. Clock?
